capital also became multi billion dollar players in the crypto bull market the 5th of the book takes a deep dive into the 2022 bear market exploring how crypto spectacularly crashed from a multi trillion dollar valuation and why the implosion of the terra stablecoin caused 60bn to vanish within a few days the 6th contemplates the events that led to the implosion of sam bankman fried s crypto exchange ftx once valued at 32bn after a meteoric 4yr rise

the science fiction film in contemporary hollywood focuses on the american science fiction sf film during the period 2001 2020 in order to provide a theoretical mapping of the genre in the context of conglomerate hollywood using a social semiotics approach in a systematic corpus of films the book argues that the sf film can be delineated by two semiotic squares the first one centering on the genre s more than human ontologies sf bodies and the second one focusing on its imaginative worlds sf worlds based on this theoretical framework the book examines the genre in six cycles which are placed in their historical context and are analyzed in relation to cultural discourses such as technological embodiment race animal human relations environmentalism global capitalism and the techno scientific empire by considering these cycles which include superhero films creature films space operas among others as expressions of the genre s basic oppositions the book facilitates the comparison and juxtaposition of films that have rarely been discussed in tandem offering a new perspective on the multiple articulations of the sf film in the new millennium

lenin lived a controversial life and has had a deeply controversial reputation in the centenary since his death 21 january 1924 his rise from a conventional educated provincial and middle class background to become not only the leader even dictator over the largest country on earth is dramatic and vital in itself but it is only part of the story even after his death he was unchallenged as the chief inspirer of a disparate world revolutionary movement which rocked the dominant capitalist world for most of the twentieth century his admirers and disciples included major intellectual and cultural figures such as brecht picasso sartre franz fanon and pablo neruda disparate radical activists and revolutionaries such as ho chi minh joseph stalin mao ze dong fidel castro che guevara josip broz tito terrorist groups such as the red brigades and baader meinhof and many liberation movements despite this his work and influence have often been written off as no longer relevant and many today consider this to be so lenin has they claim had his day even though he is still revered in china the world s most populous country however lenin like his mentor marx has had a tendency to rise from apparent decline and oblivion to renewed force and influence this study examines the key elements of lenin s life and career the consolidation of his ideas into the doctrines of leninism the influence of leninism in promoting revolutionary movements around the globe and the currently disputed issue of whether his ideas still have any relevance today in particular while considering his views on the role of the revolutionary party often seen as the centrepiece of his theory and practice this account identifies the root of lenin s global influence in his opposition to capitalist imperialism and as a bedrock foundation for the opposition of many to fascism and associated ideologies while recognizing that lenin s reputation has reached its lowest point not least in his home country where his legacy is reviled by vladimir putin and other contemporary leaders the book concludes by weighing up the contemporary arguments of those who believe that lenin still lives

April 23rd is a commonly accepted approximation based on the likely timing of baptisms relative to births in Elizabethan England. It's a date chosen for convenience and tradition. 2. Are there any other documents that could help establish Shakespeare's birthdate more precisely? Unfortunately, no other definitive documents exist. Records from that time period were often incomplete or inconsistent. 3. Why wasn't a birth certificate recorded for Shakespeare? Formal birth registration didn't exist in England during the Elizabethan era. Baptism records served as the closest equivalent for official record-keeping. 4. What impact does the uncertainty surrounding his birthdate have on our understanding of his life and works? It has minimal impact on the

understanding of his works themselves. However, it highlights the limitations of historical records and the challenges faced by biographers. 5. Is there ongoing research to find out more about Shakespeare's birth? While unlikely to find a precise date, scholarly research continually examines related documents and contextual information to gain a better understanding of his early life.
